

Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are and how they are used by the Data Controller, Gpack Spa, with registered office in via Achille Grandi, 6 20060 Truccazzano (MI). Moreover, it describes the collected information, how it is used and how the preferences expressed about cookies are controlled.

You can withdraw your consent at any time by going to the cookie icon at the bottom left of every page on our website. Your consent applies for the domain www.gpack.eu only.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files used to collect information. They are saved on your device when a website is uploaded on the browser you are using. **Cookies are necessary for the proper functioning of the website, to allow a better browsing experience and to have information about the performance of the website for a possible improvement.**

There are different types of cookies:

- **First-Party Cookies:** cookies transmitted directly by the browsed website.
- **Third-Party Cookies:** cookies transmitted by other websites or web servers.
- **Session Cookies:** cookies that are automatically deleted once the user closes the browser.
- **Persistent Cookies:** cookies that are not automatically deleted closing the browser, but they are saved on the user's device.

What cookies are used on this site and for what purpose are they used?

Our website uses the following cookies:

wpEmojiSettingsSupports	This cookie is set by wordpress when the user interacts with the emojis on a WordPress website. It is necessary to determine if the browser supports the emojis visualisation properly.	Session	Necessary
wp-wpml_current_language	This cookie is set by the WordPress WPML Plugin to memorise the language selected by the user. It is necessary to ensure that the website is shown in the selected language, improving the browsing experience.	Session	Functional

yt-remote-session-app	YouTube uses this cookie to store user's preferences and interface information of the embedded YouTube video player.	Session	Functional
yt-remote-cast-installed	YouTube uses this cookie to store the user's video player preferences when using embedded YouTube videos.	Session	Functional
yt-remote-session-name	YouTube uses this cookie to store the user's video player preferences using an embedded YouTube video.	Session	Functional
yt-remote-fast-check-period	YouTube uses this cookie to store the user's video player preferences for embedded YouTube videos.	Session	Functional
YSC	Youtube uses this cookie to track the views of videos embedded in Youtube pages.	Session	Advertisement
VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE	YouTube uses this cookie to measure bandwidth, determining whether the user receives the new or old player interface.	6 months	Advertisement
VISITOR_PRIVACY_METADATA	YouTube sets this cookie to store the user's consent status for the current domain.	6 months	Advertisement

Necessary Cookies: cookies necessary to ensure the full functionality of our site. They allow us to maintain your session and prevent any security risks. They do not collect or store any personal information.

Functional Cookies: cookies useful to facilitate effective use of the site by the user and thus favor a personalized browsing experience.

Advertising cookies: Advertising cookies are used to provide visitors with personalised advertisements based on the pages they have previously visited and to analyse the effectiveness of the advertising campaign.
